MATTHEW 28:19-20






Sixteen years ago, Harvest Church launched with a simple mission: We exist to glorify God by making disciples of all nations. We've committed ourselves to raising up more disciples in Central Indiana who will step onto God's mission wherever He would send.

The Bible shows us that the heart of God is to multiply – disciples and churches - in every tongue, tribe and nation. At Harvest, we've taken the Great Commission seriously! We have sent disciple-makers into our neighborhoods and to the nations. Each week, we remind our church family that we are a gathering of missionaries, meeting to worship, but then stepping out to make Christ known in our community, workplaces, and relationships as we live life in the Harvest.

Harvest Church is in a season of unprecedented growth and commitment. 


2007 Launch Sunday 2013 Rise Up Campaign


## WHY MULTIPLY?

## MULTIPLY DISCIPLES

Multiplying disciples means raising up worshipers who will live on mission for God. Every part of our ministry is built to make disciples and that includes our facility. When we moved onto the River Road property in 2015, we purchased 17 acres while building the first phase of a long-term plan. We knew the time would come to build again as more disciples were made and by God's grace, the opportunity is now in front of us.




WEST ELEVATION SCALE: 1/16" = 1'.0"

In the next two years, Harvest Church will make room for more worshipers by constructing an additional 34,000 square feet of ministry space. This will include a new 1,100 seat worship center, roughly doubling our current capacity. A new lobby and outdoor space will improve opportunities for fellowship and ministry each weekend and throughout the week. We will also move our Early Childhood areas closer to the new worship center and complete additional space for our ministry staff.

## MULTIPLY CHURCHES



Throughout the Bible, we see the people of God gathering for worship and then going to live life on mission for God in their communities. We have the same opportunity today. Starting in 2024, in addition to our Carmel location, we will begin planting congregations of Harvest Church in key communities on the north side of the city starting with Westfield. As people give generously to the Multiply Campaign, we plan to secure a location, launch this new ministry, and hire staff as we grow to one church family in multiple locations.





Along with planting new congregations of Harvest Church, we will also plant autonomous, disciple-making churches in Central Indiana and around the world. With the Multiply Campaign we will fully launch the Harvest Ministry Residency with focused training in pastoral ministry, church planting, international missions, and worship leadership.


#### GOAL #1 IS FOR 100% ENGAGEMENT BY EVERYONE WHO CALLS HARVEST THEIR HOME.

The Multiply Campaign is a two-year stewardship initiative that brings us to a key moment of faith in our church. The addition to our facility, the launch of a new congregation, and the preparation to send more church planters and teams out into the harvest will require sacrifice above and beyond our annual ministry budgets for 2024 and 2025. We're asking you to consider what God would have you give over these next two years.







## COMMITMENT & GIFT CHART

This Giving Chart represents a breakdown of commitments required to meet the \$6,000,000 campaign goal. Allow this gift chart to be a discipleship tool for you.





## GIVING LADDER

- Each rung of this Giving Ladder represents growth in a lifestyle of giving and sacrifice. These are not rungs you slowly ascend to get to God but simply a way to evaluate your growth in giving. Scripture encourages us to grow in every facet of our walk with Christ, including the area of giving (2 Corinthians 8:7).
- We're asking that over the next several weeks, you would first pray in how God would have you step out in faith and what you would give above and beyond your normal tithe. Consider where your giving is based on this Giving Ladder and then prayerfully consider next steps.

#### + INITIAL GIVER

Someone who has not yet given to Harvest Church. This is the first step toward inviting God to be a part of your finances and becoming someone who invests where they will have eternal impact for God's glory.

#### + CONSISTENT GIVER

Someone who is a regular giver, giving many times through recurring payments. Consistent givers start to think of their giving in the same way they would about other expenses in their budget that are paid regardless of seasons of feast or famine. To provide more clarity, we've classified this as someone who makes six or more gifts per year.

#### INTENTIONAL GIVER

Intentional givers think about their giving in relation to other things they spend their money on. They consider a percentage or amount they want to consciously grow in their giving. Intentional givers look at their budget and consider how their giving reflects their view of God and commitment to build His Kingdom.

#### + SACRIFICIAL GIVER

Someone who is no longer thinking, "What am I supposed to give?" but rather "What am I not giving and why?" This person is less concerned about the 10 or 15 percent and more concerned about the 90 or 85 percent. Sacrificial givers decide to make changes that cost them something in their lifestyle.

#### + LEGACY GIVER

Legacy givers are thinking past this year and moving toward long-term impact for their local church, their family, and eternity. They make decisions in the short-term that have longer-term effects on their giving capacity. Legacy givers consider the impact that every personal asset has on their ability to be generous. This person is no longer asking the question, "God, how much are you asking me to give?" Instead, this person is asking, "God, how much are you asking me to keep?"



### Then we hope that you will decide and then commit and participate with us in this season of multiplication.

We know God will do more than we ever imagined in the north suburbs of Indianapolis and beyond. Disciples will be multiplied. Worshipers will be sent out onto the mission of God. Lives will be changed and churches will be planted. Harvest Church, let's step up, and step out to MULTIPLY for God's glory.
